TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF POLICIES

I. POLICY

- A. The intent of this section is to ensure that the Corrections Division operates in accordance with Sheriff's Office policies and procedures, as outlined in Title 15. There may be situations that require temporary operation contrary to Sheriff's Office, Corrections Division, policies and procedures.

II. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. When it is determined that a situation exists that precludes the Sheriff's Office compliance with its policies and procedures, a temporary suspension may be invoked by this policy as provided through Title 15, Section 1012. Permission to give this temporary suspension may only be granted by the Corrections Commander, or in his absence, a Corrections Lieutenant.
- B. Emergency situations may require immediate action from the Facility Supervisor with notification to the Corrections Commander, or Corrections Lieutenant in his absence, at the first available time.
- C. Documentation shall be completed and forwarded prior to the conclusion of the shift.
