BOMB THREAT/BOMB EXPLOSION

---

I. POLICY

- A. Corrections Division staff will handle bomb threats and/or explosions in a professional and expedient manner in accordance with this policy to ensure the information is disseminated and to further prevent damage, injury to staff, visitors, inmates, and the surrounding community.
- B. This policy is to be implemented in conjunction with Sheriff's General Order 416.00 - Special Enforcement Response Teams.

II. STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES

A. Staff Member Receiving the Bomb Threat

- 1. The custody staff member receiving the bomb threat will be responsible for recording the information they receive and provide it to the Facility Supervisor.
- 2. The staff member should try to ascertain the following information:
  - a) The location of the bomb;
  - b) When the bomb is supposed to explode;
  - c) Any description of the caller's voice, demeanor or background noise from the call; and
  - d) From where the person is calling.
